## From the Pastor's Desk ...

Dear Hamburg Presbyterian church,

~Mark 12:30-31 says, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength The second is this: 'Love your neighbor as yourself. There is no commandment greater than these."

~Proverbs 21:31 says, "To do righteousness and justice is more acceptable to the Lord than sacrifice."

~ The Book of Order, W-5.0304 states, "God sends the Church to work for justice in the world: exercising its power for the common good; dealing honestly in personal and public spheres; seeking dignity and freedom for all people..."

At the July Presbytery meeting, which focused on Anti-Racism, the Rev. Steve Hong kicked off our explorations into racism by giving a thought and heart provoking Homily. In September, the Council of the Presbytery of WNY voted on the 2021-2023 Presbytery-wide theme of Social Justice, focusing on Anti-Racism. At the October Presbytery meeting the Rev. Dr. Cornell Edmonds gave a moving Homily on Anti-Racism.
